



This grant gave me the opportunity to increase my knowledge on the management of IBD patients in general and the management of pregnancy. At the Erasmus MC, I attended the IBD specialist/pregnancy clinics, which increased my knowledge and enriched my experience. Further I attended IBD endoscopy, double-balloon enteroscopy, and intestinal ultrasound. These outlined the whole care path diagram, which I intended to incorporate partly in our IBD center. And the weekly research meeting broadened my knowledge and shed the lights for my new clinical studies about EBV infection, as well the habitual dietary and gut microbiome. Participating in the Erasmus MC pregnancy clinic also gave me the opportunity to finish my part of first Chinese IBD pregnancy management consensus.

It was really a unique and fantastic learning experience which will benefit me for life. I really want to express my sincerely gratitude to ECCO-AOCC, and my supervisor Prof. C.J.van der Woude.
